

## PART 3 HANDOUT – JUNCTIONS TALK THROUGH SCRIPT

Take the next road on the left (approaching in 3rd / 4th gear)

- 1 Mirrors interior left
- 2 Signal down left
- 3 Position 1 metre from kerb
- 4 Gentle brake to 10 mph
- 5 Clutch down (3 car lengths from corner)
- 6 Select 2nd gear
- 7 Ease clutch up
- 8 Follow kerb (corner of windscreen)
- 9 Steer left
- 10 Mirrors interior and right in new road

Take the next road on the right

- 1 Mirrors interior right
- 2 Signal up right
- 3 Position left of centre
- 4 Gentle brake to 10 mph
- 5 Assess – can we walk across?
- 6 Clutch down (3 car lengths from corner)
- 7 Select 2nd gear
- 8 Ease clutch up
- 9 Use reference point (door mirror to centre line)

10 Steer right

11 Mirrors interior and right in new road

At the end of the road turn left

1 Mirrors interior and left

2 Signal left

3 Position 1 metre from kerb

4 Gentle brake

5 Clutch down

6 3 mph / 3 car lengths from line

7 Pause at give way line

8 Observations – Right, Left, Right (minimum)

9 Decide if safe

10 Act

At the end of the road turn right

1 Mirrors interior and right

2 Signal right

3 Position left of centre

4 Gentle brake

5 Clutch down

6 3 mph / 3 car lengths from line

7 Pause at give way line

8 Observations – Right, Left, Right (minimum)

9 Decide if safe

10 Act

#### COACHING NOTES

- Explain WHY we do each step
- Use LADA (Look, Assess, Decide, Act)
- Discuss Open vs Closed junctions

- Highlight pedestrians and priorities
- Watch for coasting
- Move quickly from telling → prompting → Q&A;
- Avoid repetitive instruction
